Element Name:

Ghona Chanja: Kalasha ritual during the winter solstice festival (Chawmos) at the Indrein Altar to give offerings to the visiting deity – *Balumain*

Community (ies) concerned:

The element inventoried and its details mentioned only pertain to the Bumburet valley in detail. The practice of Ghona Chanja takes place in Rumbur for the deity Balumain as well, while in Birir the practice is carried out in reverence to the deity *Praba*. The rituals take place during the *dic* (a sacred period for the Kalasha) and are only meant for the local community. Outsiders are involved sparsely after having gone through a purification ritual.
